REACH Compliance Statement

The European Regulation 1907/2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation and Authorization of Chemicals (REACH) and Directive 2006/121/EC, to streamline and improve the former legislative framework on chemicals of the European Union (EU). REACH places a greater responsibility on industry to manage the risk that chemicals may pose to health and the environment.

Under the structure of REACH regulation IHI lonbond is a downstream user to all our customers worldwide. We do not manufacture "substances" or "preparations" and our products do not involve "the intentional release of substances". Chemical substances contained in our goods, which may possibly be subject to registration, have to be registered exclusively by our suppliers.

We have identified all substances that we use in the course of our industrial activities and are in constant contact with our suppliers to seek formal assurance of their intention to comply with the registration requirements of REACH. Where our suppliers are reliant on an actor up the supply chain to register for substances which they provide to us we have requested that they qualify their intention to comply with REACH, so that substances we use will remain available for use in the future.

With regard to the requirement of Article 33 of REACH: "Duty to communicate information on substances in articles", we continually maintain contact with our suppliers to avoid Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC, Annex XIV) from being included in our products.

Based on the response statements of our suppliers, no materials from ECHA SVHC Candidate/Authorization list with more then 0,1% (w/w) percent, are included in our products or package materials.

With regard to requirement of Article 67 of REACH "General provisions", Para. 1, we declare that none of the substances in the conditions of restriction as per Annex XVII, are present in lonbond products or package materials.

As the REACH regulation is updated frequently, for the major changes afterwards, such as the addition of SVHC substances into Annex VIV or the addition of substances in Annex XVII, Ionbond will continually monitor the European Chemical Agency (ECHA) publications and update this statement as needed.
